# Our Traditional Business Assets

- 932,500 m3 of tenured sawlog supply, and good access to purchased sawlogs
- Site I and Site II sawmills with 435 million board feet of lumber capacity, with the prospect for consistent profitability following modernization and upgrading
- Idled newsprint facility, which we believe has exciting future potential as a bioenergy/bio-products production center; and
- A co-dependent pulp mill partner we can help “fibre up” for decades to come.



# Our Co-generation Project

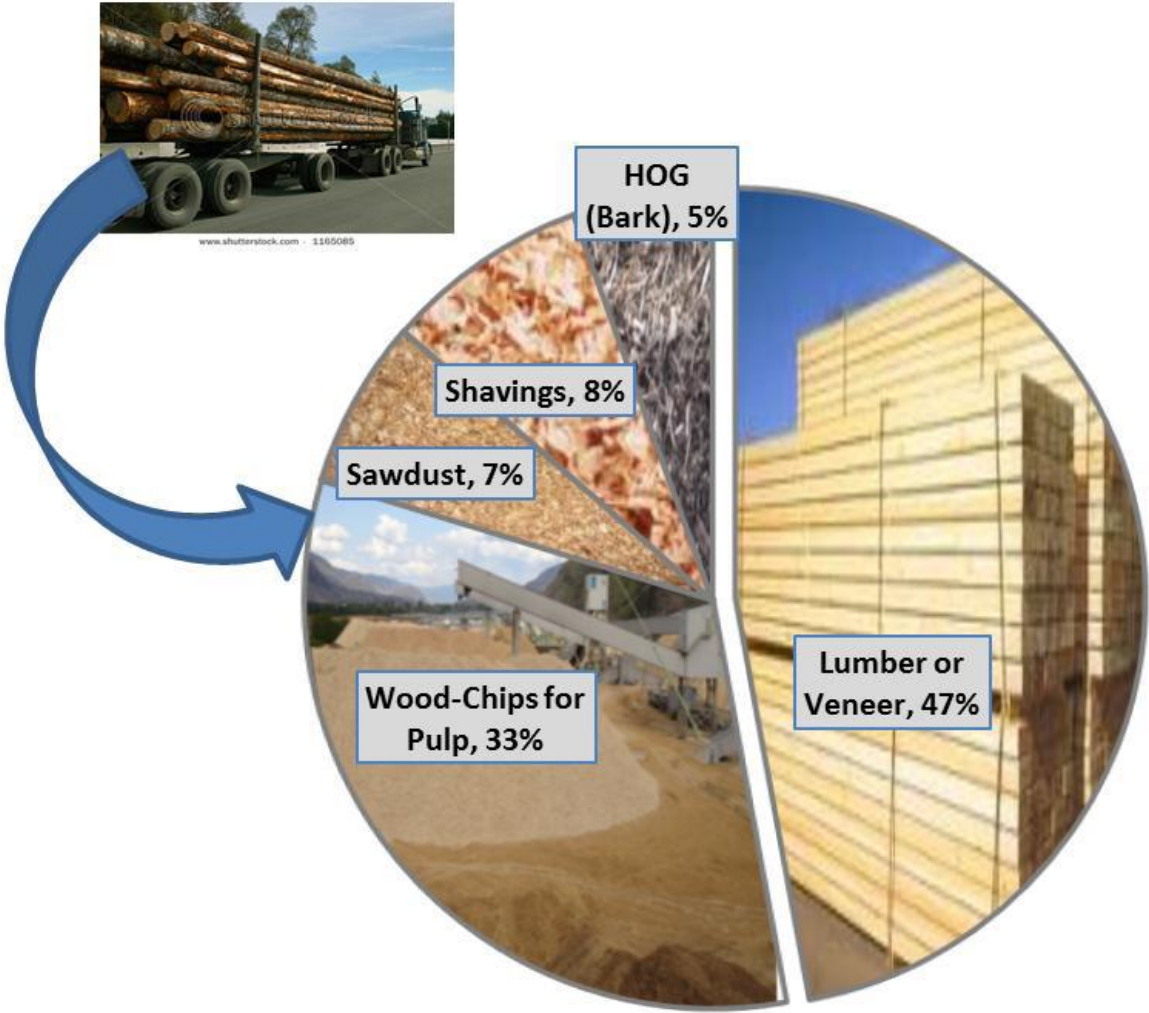
- 36 MW gross capacity, equal to power for 24,000 homes
- Located close to supply of bio-mass fuel from Conifex sawmills
- 20 year contract with BC Hydro
- Re-purposing existing equipment
